






"Climate Cafe" Easy Read Visual Story

The **café** at **B arts**, called **Bread in Common**, will be open for lunch, drinks and snacks.




The **café** may be a little bit **noisy.**

This is **Kath**


She will welcome you to Climate Cafe

This is Rebecca






She will be at Climate Café in the main space

You can learn to knit




You can learn to **sew** on a **sewing machine**




There are **different creative activities** every month at Climate Café.

You can stay at Climate Café for as long as you would like to.




The quietest time is 10-11am
